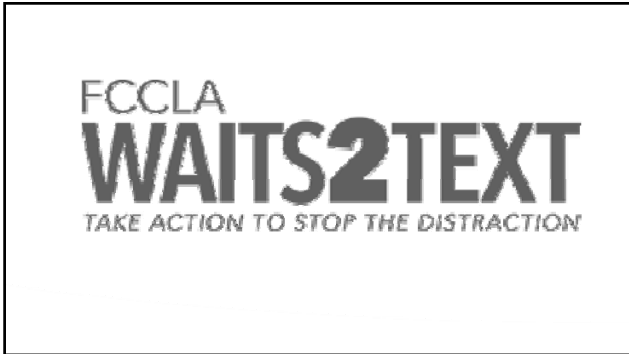

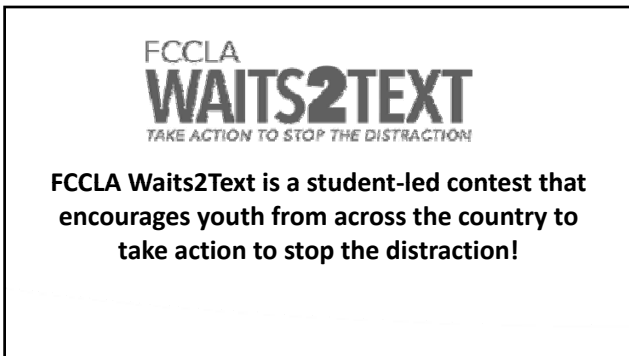
Through peer education, help your friends arrive alive and lower the number one cause of death for youth in America: automobile crashes.

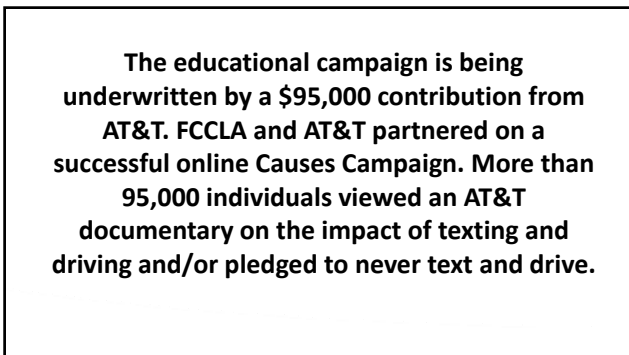
FACTS Units

- **Bridge the Gap** - Promote conversation and training for parents of teens as they work together to enhance traffic safety.









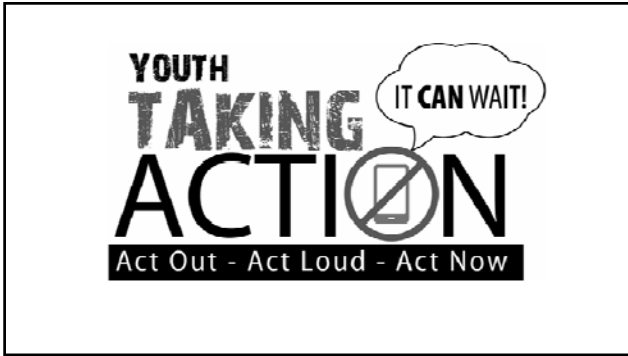
Program Goals

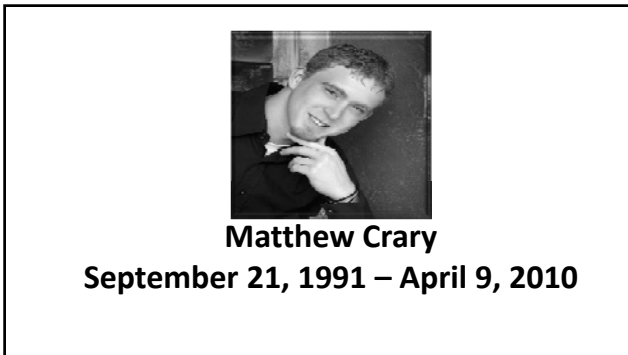
