

- Safety Checkpoint in 2010 indicated:
- CSS used-39
- CSS used incorrectly-435
- Total number of cars checked -4028 reservation wide
  was usage rate
  8.2% usage \*\*

#### 2013 CSS Observation Reservation wide

- Observed-354
- CSS usage-241
- CSS not used-113
- Percentage of use-52%

Our birth rate for the past 5 years averages 300+ \*






Activities that Enforce the laws of the Lakota's
