


• To qualify for funding, the state must have as a part of its GDL program, for all new driver under the age of 21, a permit stage and an intermediate stage that leads to full licensure. • Encourages states to adopt and implement the Novice Teen Driver Education and Training Administrative Standards (NTDETAS)	
<ul> <li>MAP-21 GDL Funding</li> <li>Permit stage must be a minimum of 6 months and learner cannot exit before age 16.</li> <li>To complete the permit stage, the learner must successfully complete a driver education or training course that is certified by the state.</li> </ul>	

<ul> <li>MAP-21 GDL Funding</li> <li>Intermediate stage must be a minimum of 6 months and learner cannot exit before age 18. Includes various requirements and restrictions.</li> <li>NHTSA recognizes the importance of driver education or training as an important highway safety countermeasure for the reduction of teen crashes and fatalities.</li> <li>http://www.anstse.info/PDF's/MAP-21.pdf</li> </ul>
