





 Virginia males account for about 68% of DUIs in the Commonwealth



 Impaired driving crashes are most prevalent among 18-35 year olds

- Unbuckled fatalities occur at higher rates on rural roads
- Pickup drivers have lower seatbelt use rates





- First year partnership with Richmond Raceway
- Expanded to Martinsville Speedway and several small tracks

Went digital during COVID







- Street team engages with fans in the tailgate lots
- Outreach footprint in the fan engagement or midway area

- Collect surveys and safe driver pledges in exchange for small token like koozie or lanyard- sustaining the message




Over the past 12 months, how many times have you driven when you've had too much to drink?


Have you ever been a passenger in a car with an intoxicated driver?







Have you ever used a taxi or ride-sharing app because you were too drunk to drive?




