

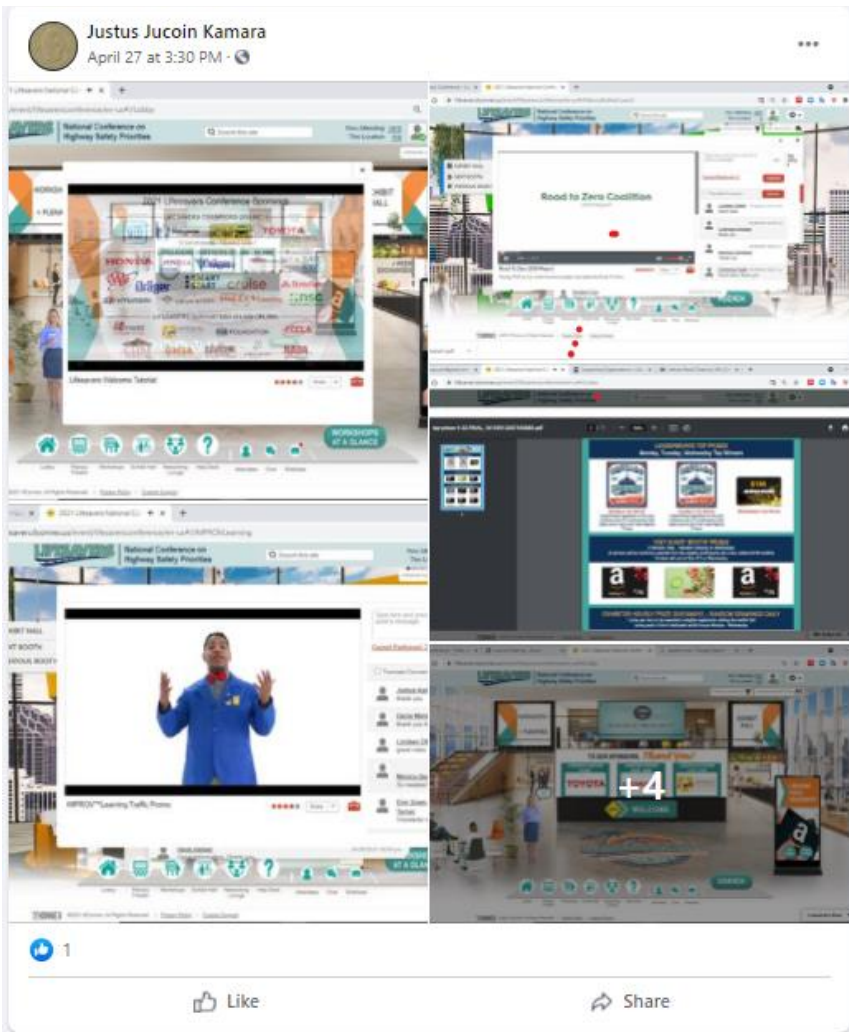

Soheil was awarded a \$1,000 Scholarship to attend the 38th annual Lifesavers National Conference on Highway Safety Priorities in Tampa, Florida March 15-17, 2020. Fifty students from around the world were meticulously selected to attend the conference. The conference is the nation's largest highway safety conference focused on eliminating traffic deaths and serious injuries for those on the roadways. 
