



### Traffic Safety Initiatives Video Series




# Safe, Quick Clearance of Traffic Incidents Toolkit



The <u>Distracted Driving Toolkit</u> provides law enforcement chief executives, command staff, first-line supervisors, and patrol officers with effective strategies that have been used by others to improve distracted driving education and enforcement in their communities, along with tactics to reduce officer distraction in patrol vehicles.
