

2024 Traffic Safety Scholars (TSS) Program Terms & Conditions

Eligibility Requirements

You must be a student enrolled on a full- or part-time basis at an accredited college or university during the Fall of 2023 and Spring of 2024. Previous TSS applicants and recipients are encouraged to apply.

Evaluation Criteria

All qualified and eligible applications must include a 60-90-second video that meets the TSS criteria. This video will be reviewed by a committee of traffic safety experts.

Applicants may be subject to an interview with the Review Committee, who reserves the right to not award scholarships if there are no suitable applicants and the right to limit the number of scholars selected based upon institution and/or affiliation.

TSS Awards

Selected students will receive a TSS exclusive reduced conference registration rate of \$100. Selected students who live and/or attend school within 50 miles of Denver, Colorado will be awarded a \$500 scholarship; all others will receive \$1,000. The scholarship must be used to defray Lifesavers Conference expenses (i.e., registration, airfare, accommodations). A letter of accreditation and a check will be mailed to the student **after** the conference and upon completion of the requirements noted below.

<u>Requirements – ALL MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS MUST BE FULFILLED TO RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT – NO EXCEPTIONS</u>

- Participate in the online pre-conference orientation in early March 2024.
- Pay the \$100 TSS exclusive registration fee that guarantees admission to more than 70 workshops, three plenary sessions, exhibit hall, two lunches and refreshment breaks, and networking meetings with traffic safety professionals.
- Attend the **entire** conference (April 6-9, 2024), which also includes participation in a pre-conference panel and reception with Lifesavers Planning Committee members and industry leaders on Saturday afternoon, April 6, and a debrief breakfast meeting on Tuesday morning, April 9.
- Post about their Lifesavers experience using social media (Facebook, LinkedIn, college/university
 website, blogging site) during and/or immediately after the conference and forward the link to
 Lifesavers for future promotional purposes. (2017-2023 Traffic Safety Scholar posts can be viewed on

Special lodging rates for the conference hotels are available only via the Lifesavers Conference Website Hotel/Travel page, although you are not required to stay at a conference hotel.
