


# BALTIMORE CITY *is* *easy to* NAVIGATE

## Expanded Coverage for the Lifesavers Conference

The Lifesavers Conference and Visit Baltimore's safety partners have implemented a program during all events to ensure the safety of all attendees. Discussions are held regularly to review the 2026 Lifesavers Conference schedule of events so we are able to plan accordingly for appropriate safety resources and deployments.

Attendees can expect an increase in safety precautions including:

- Visit Baltimore is working in tandem with Tactical Protective Services (TPS) to assist in additional presence around the conference footprint. The security team will provide coverage on the outside perimeter of the BCC, including monitoring the attendees traversing to and from the major hotels as well as physical checks of the hotels and the Inner Harbor area. You can find them on foot or on patrol in a public safety vehicle.
- Increased safety protocols by the Downtown and Waterfront partnerships around the Convention Center, contracted hotels and off-site event venues used by the group, including additional presence by private security contractors and public law enforcement agencies at every level.
- Parking garage monitoring in the downtown Baltimore area.


